 - First year since Covid at full scale and participation
 - Can't leave the Fair without a committee chair during the day, need an additional chairperson for the week

 - Concern over if we will have people to vote for opening board positions
 - Communications this year are really good to the school community
 - Reach out to personally to ask

Principal's Report - Wayne Thornes

- ★ Reopening to volunteers in the classrooms again
 - Teachers will start emailing opportunities
 - Will begin Monday after Spring Break

- ★ School Covid numbers are 3 cases in three weeks
- ★ Raptor System Volunteer and Visitor check in system
 - Will co-exist with the old system for the rest of the school year
 - If a volunteer registered more than 3 years ago, the volunteer will need to register again
 - Swipe drivers license and system will do a quick background check first time checking in and using
 - o All following times the front desk can check the volunteer/visitor in
 - Caregivers/Parents can be a visitor if they are not registered as a volunteer or not allowed to volunteer
 - Faster turn around for visitor checks
 - Will probably need a school volunteer coordinator
 - Enrichment teachers will need to go through the process
 - Volunteer system will not clear until 4:30 to accommodate
- ★ Read across America last week
 - Laura and Wayne Read Piggie and Gerald and had a lot of fun!
- ★ Science Fair is going on
 - 70 boards submitted and on display in the gymnasium
 - 4th and 5th grade PBL presentations were today
 - Tuesday is science fair presentations and judging for non-4th and 5th graders
 - Awards will be streamed on Wednesday morning announcements
- ★ Conferences are the next three days
- ★ High Density Tutoring
 - 3 extra hours for identified students per week
 - using COVID funds
 - starts after Spring Break
- ★ Budget
 - Maintaining current numbers of teaching staff and adding one 5th grade teacher
 - Maintaining classified staff
 - 10 kids will be sent to Camp Soul bridge program for the summer
 - Budget looks good
