 - Cost of shade structure plus installation is just above \$25,000
 - Solar shade structure came bid out at more than \$50,000 for one
 - Question was posed if we should continue to pursue a solar shade structure with the additional costs
 - Becky Woodcox will help to write grants for solar if interested
 - Possibility proposed of adding an additional shade structure in the school yard as a learning space with a small solar piece
 - PTO recommendation for the money raised for shade structures is for the three canvas structures presented at the meeting
