### President's Report - Britt Mactavish

- ★ Britt asked for feedback on agendas and contact notifications

# Principal's Report - Wayne Thornes

- ★ Huge thank you for financial help with Eco Week
  - Apologize for the confusion in funding
  - Straightened out and families and staff were grateful for the support
- ★ Idea presented for Eco themed shirts if there is a Shepardson Clothing sale. Add up charge to help fund ECO week in the future
  - Bohemian used to fund field trips and have recently pulled that funding, so buses were paid for through the ECO week payments from the school community
- ★ Laura Beese is requesting a new soundboard
  - Existing soundboard has shorted out. It is a heavily used item in the music classroom and for extracurricular activities. Ask is around \$1000
  - Impacts all 420 students and the preschool program
  - The formal ask will be presented during the General Meeting
- ★ Random Thank You to the parent that helped a middle school student with a bike accident near school

The Shepardson PTO mission is to promote the welfare of the students in the home, school, and community and to help build a close relationship between the student, parents and school staff/faculty.

- ★ Furniture is a new need for tech lab, \$500 per station
  - Life expectancy of the current computers is this year
  - District is not upgrading technology labs anymore since providing Chrome books for all students
  - The school desires a desktop for each student verses using with student individual laptops
  - The laptops are not powerful enough to do the work the students are doing on them
  - Going down to one cart per class for the chrome books, not sustainable for the K-2
- ★ Probably done fundraising for sunshades
  - Are in the bid process
  - Engineering design review is happening soon
  - 6-9 month permitting process through the state
  - District will be bidding at same time
  - Two Shade sails canvas
  - One solar shade 350 square feet of area and solar panels
    - Sandbox solar gave estimate for the panels and sun shade
- ★ Air-conditioning upgrade quote for Shepardson could be up to 1 million dollars
  - To provide air conditioning, would take a mill levy and then it will take 10 years to implement
  - Possibility of mini-splits, \$3000 per classroom and an upgrade to the school electrical system
- ★ Do we want to Invite the mobile vaccination clinic back to Shepardson?
  - Yes
