  - Tracking down outstanding \$800 from Ragnar Race event
  - Have approximately \$60,000 cash; \$29,750 grants for a total of \$90,650 raised and available now, which will cover the cost of the equipment
  - Have \$45,000 in grant applications outstanding and awaiting answers
  - Need to finish raising the rest of the money (\$29,000) by February
