Officers' Reports

President's Report—Kelli Wallace, David Worford

- Welcome to a new year, new way of doing things
- Things seem to be going well so far
- Committee Openings
 - Shepardson gear (t-shirts, etc)
 - Teacher Appreciation BBQ

Principal's Report—Wayne Thornes

- Things are going as well as possible
- Staff is working so hard
- Huge collaborations are taking place, using new tools
- Technology is definitely the biggest speed bump
- Students are very resilient
- Playground is in!
 - Kids and community seem to love it
- Free lunches are available daily from 11:00am-1:00pm for all kids
- Shepardson is a remote learning support center
 - o This is a program available to students who need extra help
 - o 10 Shepardson students, 10 O'Dea students
 - o Being run by Mr. George
- Budget Crisis
 - PSD-V has more students than money as the District was not expecting the enrollment to be as large as it is.
 - 1800 elementary students

- Shepardson enrollment has dropped considerably
 - PSD-V option
 - Other families have withdrawn their student to attend private or charter schools
 - Kindergarten families are choosing to defer enrollment for a year as Kinder is extremely hard to do remotely
- State won't be able to fully fund schools
- Shepardson is currently staffed appropriately (1:20 or better)
- Due to having to return money to the District for students who are no longer enrolled at Shepardson we need to look at Classified staff and Operating Budget
 - Asking PTO to help with the Operating Budget so we can retain our Classified staff (extremely valuable, necessary)
 - Looking at ways to redirect money: Field trips, coffee fund, garden fund, SeeSaw, testing support, etc.
 - It was moved and seconded to take the remaining funds for the 2020-2021 school year to cover the Operating Budget
 - Discussion, approved unanimously

Treasurer's Report—Sarah Putman

- Received several King Soopers checks since the COVID mail stoppage has been lifted
- Received a company's matching donation from 2019
- Taxes are done (ahead of the game!)
- Fall grant is delayed until after Read-A-Thon
- We are able to increase the Teacher Classroom Fund back up to \$100 from \$75 if we would like to do so
 - Total cost \$875 to budget
 - Moved, seconded, approved to increase the Teacher Classroom Fund to \$100

Staff Report—Andie Kirkwood

- Overwhelming thanks for the playground; everyone loves watching the kids play
- Thank you to PTO for support for SeeSaw
- Request opportunity to buy Shepardson gear
- Staff is brainstorming ideas for the Read-A-Thon and storybook costume celebration
- Mr. George and Mrs. Mitchell are working with kids in need of extra help and support at the school and they need snack for these kiddos
 - Leentja offered the class parents to help (will be sending out email ASAP)
