# Principal's Report— Wayne Thornes

- ★ Thank you for the shade structures!
  - Students have loved them
  - Helped students regulate their temperatures
  - Came at the perfect time of the year
- ★ 430 students enrolled projected at 388
  - o 69 kindergarteners 20% school of choice
  - Largest class is 4<sup>th</sup> grade!
- ★ School year is off to a good start
- ★ Incidence on the school bus was not a Shepardson para hire
  - District is taking big steps to make sure it doesn't happen again
- ★ Shepardson achieved pre-pandemic scores in spring CMAS testing
  - Still not at goals for achievement
- ★ New literacy curriculum is in place
- ★ Looking into the possibility to fund a new gym sound system
  - School is asking PTO for partial funding
- ★ Shepardson is a PBL school Project Based Learning
  - The community and schools interact together
  - Teacher teams are meeting already to talk about their plans
